Victoria Day Trip (Offered on 9/25/2010)

An early morning scenic ferry transports you to Vancouver Island to visit the incomparable and lovely Butchart Gardens. Set on over 50 acres, Butchart Gardens are among the world's most beautiful and are a veritable explosion of color and fragrances. Then, take a short sightseeing tour of the "City of Gardens," Victoria, and enjoy leisure time to explore this charming, seaside city. This evening you will journey back to the mainland via a short ferry ride.

This option is operated by a local representative. A pre night stay is required to participate in this option for US and Canadian clients - does not apply to UK clients. *Duration: Approximately 12 hours.* Transportation is included.

Jasper Rafting Tours (Offered on 9/28/2010)

Watch as they row through six to eight short sets of mild rapids as well as calm stretches over the 16 kilometers of rivers. *Duration: Approximately 1.5 hours.* Transportation is included.

Banff, AB

Dinner and Sulphur Mountain (Offered on 10/1/2010)

Enjoy a spectacular panoramic view of six mountain ranges from the summit of Sulphur Mountain. While safely seated in a four passenger gondola cabin, you are whisked to a height of 7,486 feet above sea level in just eight minutes. At the upper gondola terminal, take in the awe-inspiring 360° views from the view decks. Return to Banff and enjoy dinner at a favorite local restaurant on Banff Avenue, in the heart of the popular shopping area.

Please Note: Banff's Sulphur Mountain is weather permitting during the months of November and December. Should the Gondola not be operating we will replace it with the admission to the Whyte Museum. *Duration: Approximately 3.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

The Lake Louise Experience (Offered on 10/1/2010)

Embark on a journey to spectacular Lake Louise. Upon arrival enjoy lunch at the Ski Louise Lodge. Then, board the gondola and ascend to the summit of the mountain in eight minutes, to a height of 7,486 feet above sea level. Marvel at the spectacular panoramic views of mountain ranges while keeping an eye out for wildlife indigenous to the area. At the upper gondola terminal, take in the awe-inspiring 360° views from the view decks, visit the Interpretative centre to learn about the bears in this area, their habitat, and history. Return from the summit and motorcoach to the incomparable Chateau Lake Louise; the iconic hotel perched on the edge of a sapphire blue lake, cradled by the mountains and situated within a UNESCO World Heritage site. You may choose to hike up to the tea house, take a walk around the lake or relax in the majesty of your surroundings. *Duration: Approximately 6 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
